Edward D. Jones & Co., L.P. ("Edward Jones") is the entity currently providing professional services to the Municipal Pension System ("Contractor"). Contractor is a registered broker-dealer and employs a financial advisor who directly serves the Requesting Municipality.

Steven B. Goodhue, an Edward Jones financial advisor, is an employee of Contractor that is investing on the behalf of Requesting Municipality and is paid a fee or receives compensation from a municipal pension system – indirectly through the Contractor.

Contractor and its Affiliated Entities have no actual knowledge of any such compensation or employment.

REF Item #6.

According to Contractor's records, none of Contractor's financial advisors, including Steven B. Goodhue, general partners and employees in Compliance Service, Field Supervision, Investment Banking, Product Review and Municipal Trading departments of Contractor's firm have solicited a contribution to any municipal officer in the Requesting Municipality, or to the political party or political action committee of that official. Without knowing the names of the candidates for municipal office, no search could be performed to confirm or deny whether a contribution was solicited for those individuals. Because Contractor is a large broker-dealer with over 12,000 branch offices and 40,000 employees, Contractor is unable to determine whether any such contributions have been solicited from Contractor's agents or employees outside the departments listed above.

Contractor receives payments known as revenue sharing from certain mutual fund companies, 529 plan program managers, insurance companies and retirement plan providers (collectively referred to as "product partners"). Contractor's receipt of revenue sharing payments may create a potential conflict of interest in the form of an additional financial incentive and financial benefit to Contractor, its financial advisors and equity owners in connection with the sale of products from these product partners.

Revenue sharing, as received by Contractor, involves a payment from a mutual fund company's adviser or distributor, a 529 plan program manager, an insurance company or the entity that markets an insurance contract, or a retirement plan provider. It is not an additional charge to Requesting Municipality. These payments are in addition to standard sales loads, annual sales fees, expense reimbursements, sub-transfer agent fees for maintaining client account information and providing other administrative services for mutual funds (shareholder accounting and networking fees), and reimbursements for education, marketing support and training-related expenses.

Contractor reasonably believes that its current disclosure of revenue sharing to its clients addresses this apparent conflict of interest.

You will need to prepare and send one of these disclosure forms to **each Contractor** that you have a contract for providing services to your pension plan (AND) a separate set of disclosures for each type of plan – fire, police, etc. IF ONE CONTRACTOR services two or more plans, then only one disclosure is required, but the contractor must indicate he / she is completing the disclosure for more than one plan....**PAGE 4, Question One.**

You should also prepare a brief cover letter explaining the reason you are sending this disclosure out.

➤ **Who should receive this disclosure?**

Generally there are 5 primary service providers for each pension plan but it is not limited to just these:

- Actuarial Services Investment Services Administration Services Advisory Services**
- Legal Advisory Services – usually performed by the municipal solicitor**

IF some of these services are combined through one service provider or Contractor, then you only need to send this to that one entity. **For Example**, your administrative services and actuarial services are conducted through **Robert Smith and Associates** and your contract is with this company. However, **Robert Smith and Associates** subcontracts certain portions of these services to two other companies. You need only send one disclosure to **Robert Smith and Associates**, and one to any other entity that provides specific services – other than administrative and actuarial.
